This is the Jan. issue of the "CERAMIC INDUSTRY MAGAZINE", it comes out every year in JAN., and is a treasure house of valuable technical info. everyone should have it. It is an alphabetical definition (composition & use) of ceramic raw materials. This is essential, buy it!!!

② "TIN GLAZED POTTERY" by ALAN CAIGER-SMITH (Lawrence, Ma. Merrimack book service Dec. 1973) you should have it... *** this is part history, part technical, part esthetic, quite wonderful!!!

③ "CERAMIC DATA BOOK" - Camner's Publ. Co. One S. Wabash ave. Chicago Illinois 60603. *** Names & addresses of companies (Ceramic) and what they make and sell. You can use this, it's an excellent reference.

④ "SALT GLAZED CERAMICS" by JACK TROY. (Wetmore's Gypsum 1977) *** Very good if you have a specialized interest in SALT, important to have anyway.

⑤ "CERAMICS"; by PHILIP RAWSON, Not a technical book, but essential nevertheless. *** Buy it!!! It may go out of print again. Available in U.S.A. the esthetics of Ceramics including vital insights about COLOR & GLAZE.
